

#### **BURREN | CLIFFS OF MOHER**

Enjoy an audio/visual presentation at the Burren Centre in Kilfenora. Take a guided walk through the Burren with local expert Tony Kirby, and marvel at the area's rich history and breathtaking archaeology.

**Local Flavor:** Enjoy lunch at Cassidy's pub.

**Excursion:** *The Enthralling Cliffs of Moher.* Following lunch, visit Poulnabrone Dolmen, a portal tomb dating from 2500-2000 B.C. Then, drive along the scenic Burren coast to the



majestic Cliffs of Moher, which rise 700 feet above the Atlantic Ocean. Let your jaw drop as you gaze at this mesmerizing natural wonder, and listen for the crashing of uncoiling waves below.

**Educational Focus:** *Irish Seanchaí*. Enjoy riveting tales during a session of Ireland's most famous pastime.

#### ARAN ISLANDS

#### Excursion: Aran Islands of Inishmore.

Take a ferry across Galway Bay to Inishmore, the largest of the Aran Islands. The Burren of County Clare continues on the Aran Islands and provides a stark beauty amid the ethereal landscape. People have lived here since approximately 3000 B.C., and Stone Age monuments can still be seen. The area is also famous for stone forts, which date from the Bronze Age. Visit the ruins of Dún Aengus, and admire the spectacular view.

**Local Flavor:** Enjoy lunch at Mainistir House.

#### KILLARNEY

**Excursion:** *Dingle Peninsula.* Following breakfast, depart for Killarney via the scenic Dingle Peninsula. Take a ferry from Killimer to Tarbert, and savor coastline views from the water.

**Local Flavor:** Dine on local cuisine for lunch.

Visit the Blasket Island Heritage Center, which honors the people who lived on the remote Blasket Islands until the mid-1900s. Spend free time exploring Dingle. Perhaps enjoy a treat at the legendary Murphy's Ice Cream, visit a Dingle crystal workshop or admire beautiful stained glass windows – all by artist Harry Clarke – at St. Mary's Church.

In Killarney, check in to the Malton Hotel.

#### RING OF KERRY


**Excursion:** *Ring of Kerry.* Located on the Iveragh Peninsula, the circular drive of the Ring of Kerry is declared as one of the world's most beautiful coastal drives. View a region that seems almost untouched by human hands, where emerald knolls effortlessly melt into cerulean skies and lakes shimmer with a rare brilliance.

**Meet the People:** Meet a local shepherd, who will demonstrate, with the help of loyal border collies, how to move sheep around a pasture.


